AREA C: Bounded by Tasmania Crescent (North West) and Chancellor Boulevard (North East) and College Highroad (South); and, West 6th Avenue and Chancellor Boulevard (North-South), and Drummond Drive and Blanca Street (West-East).

TOTE PLACEMENT & USE

How you place your totes is very important:

- ▶ Please leave at least 1 m of space between your totes and any obstacles such as cars, poles, trees, etc.
- ▶ Note the directions on the tote lid tote should be facing towards the street.
- ▶ Leave at least 1 m between your totes and any structures.
- Any waste must fit inside the tote with the lid firmly closed.
- ▶ When possible, set your totes out only when full.
- ➤ Totes are the property of the UEL and must be returned, or left for the next occupant, when you move.

GARBAGE (Black Tote Lid)

The following are **NOT** accepted in the gabage tote:

- ► Cardboard, paper, glass or hard plastics
- ▶ Construction, renovation, or hazardous material waste
- ▶ Electronics and batteries
- ► Flammable liquids (e.g. oil or paint)
- Needles or other medical waste

ORGANICS & YARD WASTE (Green Tote Lid)

Please cut branches to fit into the tote.

The following are **NOT** accepted in the kitchen and vard waste tote:

- Animal waste
- ▶ Branches greater than 7.62 cm (3 in.) in diameter
- ► Rocks, dirt, sod or stumps
- Plastic bags or containers
